Early Pick Up/Late Drop Off is available and requires registration and an additional fee. Hours are mornings: 7:30am and evenings until 6:15pm. Costs: \$25/week AM or PM \$50/week BOTH AM & PM

Q: On trip days, what time do field trips return?

A: All trips, unless otherwise noted, return 4:00-4:30pm. Please check the weekly schedules and bulletin board for updated times.

Q: How do I get my child's immunization records?

A: Please call your physician and ask for them to e-mail or fax them over to us. Most will fax a "camp form" saying they are up to date on all their immunizations.

Q: Can I send my child with a tablet, cell phone or electronic device?

A: Please do not. Generally, electronic devices are only permitted on field trips, unless otherwise stated by the Head Counselor. This is to prevent loss & damage of valuables and electronics.

Q: My child forgot their Camp Shirt can they still go on the trip?

A: No. Any camper going on a field trip with Camp <u>MUST</u> wear a Camp Shirt (including BEACH DAYS). Extra shirts are available for \$10/each. We recommend having an extra to make it easier throughout the summer.

Q: Can I send my child with a lunch that needs to be heated up or \$\$ to order lunch?

A: Please send your child with a lunch that can be eaten anywhere. When it is nice out we eat outside or over at the parks.

Drop Off and Pick Up

All children attending camp MUST be signed out daily by a parent, guardian or person listed on the Medical Form. Any other person picking up should be sent in a note in writing to the Boys & Girls Club.

Please bring to camp everyday:

2 Snacks: 10:30 am & 4:30 pm Lunch: 12 noon Bathing Suit & Towel (or clothes you don't mind getting wet) Sunscreen

Parents: Please apply sunscreen each day before camp; children will be reminded to reapply sunscreen before going outside. All campers will be reminded to apply sunscreen every hour when outside. Goldfish & Bluefish counselors will offer to apply sunscreen.
